2 Scope of accreditation

Accreditation of certification based on ISO/IEC 20000-1 shall be included in the EN ISO/IEC 17021-1 scope of accreditation as follows:

- Standard/normative document: ISO/IEC 20000-1
- Certification scheme: Certification of IT Service Management Systems

There are no specific sub scopes specified for this scope of accreditation.



3 Accreditation assessments

3.1 Documents to be submitted

Additional requirements compared to SAP C000:

For witnessing:

- the results of the auditee's risk analysis;
- a list of the applicable laws and regulations for IT-Service Management.

3.2 The type and content of assessments

In addition to the generic rules for the type and content of RvA assessments as defined in RvA-BR002, RvA-BR005 and SAP-C000, for this specific accreditation the requirements from the following table apply. The type, extent and content of the assessment depend on the requested scope of accreditation, existing other accreditations and the functioning of the certification body in the past (where relevant).

3.3 Reassessments and surveillance

4 Specific assessment issues

Audit time.

In case the certification body performs a combined ISO 9001/ISO 20000-1 audit and/or a combined ISO 27001/ISO 20000-1 audit, the audit time shall be calculated using IAF-MD11. Refer to clause 9.1.4.3 of ISO 20000-6 for possible adjustments of audit time for the ISO 20000-1 certification.

The certification body shall justify deviations from this calculation and it shall demonstrate to have performed an effective audit.

5 Changes to the previous version of this document

In comparison with version 4 dated February 28, 2020 the following significant changes have been made:
